I caught up with her and asked if she would walk with me to see the newly installed WASP plaque. She and her grandmother agreed...and both were overwhelmed when we arrived. She had mustered out (retired) from the Air Force only two years before. I gave her my card, asked her to stay in touch so we could invite her to the dedication ceremony. Her grandmother gave me a big hug. And they left arm in arm."

Thanks to Lindy for inspiring yet another soul, in honor of his mother, a WASP, who was a WW II inspiration. ZCF is fortunate at this Thanksgiving to have so many impactful projects like this one. We are blessed to have each other to love on, and I am so thankful to be in this club.






The Planning Committee did an amazing job setting up Nimitz Hall and presentations for a fantastic meeting!


